My name is Melany Burchett, I have been a member of the Toledo community for over 21 years now. I have volunteered, and been employed at the Toledo Pool for an accumulation of 18 years. I have been an active volunteer on KOPO (Keep Our Pool Open), now Friends of the Greater Toledo Pool Committee. I have used this facility as my own physical rehabilitation, and have first-hand witnessed the numerous others that have made incredible recoveries in their own lives from the programs we have offered.

Over the years I have worn many hats here at the pool, with the most current as the Aquatics Manager. None though more fulfilling than becoming a lesson instructor, and providing a lifelong, lifesaving skill to thousands of youths in our community and beyond. We teach lessons year-round here. Our facility has been the only pool out of 3 in Lincoln County to provide a long running successful school swim lesson program, as well as summer lessons. In 2013 we received an Award for Excellence in Aquatics Programming for School Swimming Lessons from ORPA. We had 2500 children in 4 months come through grades K-3 to learn lifelong, lifesaving skills.

I am extremely moved for the consideration you are giving us and the possibility of continuing our efforts to make a difference in our communities. There are many great needs in our state.
