I blame ODE for their incompetence in reopening schools and the quality of education rolled out for families. January 2021 was the month I said I had enough, and pulled my children out of public school to home school. Never in my life had I ever thought about home schooling but with Oregon public education I had no choice. We couldn't financially afford to enroll in a private school and really needed a break from the computers. I came across a great program with Summit Learning but they were not able to accommodate my children as enrollement was full. We are enrolled for the 2021-2022 school year and couldn't be more excited. This program allows me to continue at home learning with supplemental teachings from a teacher. This allows my children to enjoy a relationship with a teacher and lessons being taught by someone other than Mrs.Mama. The biggest help is the financial allowance for curriculum!
