

My kids can have class at home in comfort and they love it. They have classes outside, on the couch library or even the coffee shop. The teachers working remotely are amazing. Remote learning has allowed both my kids to be more confident in their studies and are retaining the information. I am allowed to be part of the learning process not only in their studies but the time allows more real world experiences. We do woodworking, farming, cooking, sewing, piano lessons, sports year round and overall it is a much better quality of life. There are no distractions that play a negative effect on their well being. They attend a christian co-op with classes every Friday with other online/homeschooling families. They actually have more socialization now than before the freedom to start class as early as 6 or as late as 7 in the evening. The layout of class assignments allows the students to get their assignments done within the timeline given.

My oldest was in private christian school from preschool upto 4th grade while my yougest was there until 1st grade. We switched to public school for a year which was not for them. They were ahead in the classroom but the daily drama/outbursts distractions effected their education. We homeschooled for part of the year but they wanted more, more of grading system. To be able to share their work and accomplishments with other peers. That's when we found online education as a win! Each year since I ask if they'd like to go back to private school, public school or our own curriculum and both boys want to stay were they are. They love this freedom to learn at their own to be home in a safe space and to spend time as a family.
