My name is Charles Davidson and I am a student at Lane Community College working towards a degree in Accounting. Today I am asking for you to invest \$290 M in the Oregon Opportunity Grant, the state's largest need based financial aid program.

I qualify for the Oregon Opportunity Grant but do not receive it. The strain on myself of paying for school during this pandemic is immense. It has taken me years to reach a point where I could attend school and further my future horizons. The impact on my education of this economic reality has been immense. Right now, over $\frac{3}{4}$ of Oregon students who qualify for and need the Oregon Opportunity Grant do not receive it, purely due to severe underfunding. If Oregon is going to recover from COVID-19, it is vital that we invest in student aid so that students can afford to finish degrees and find good paying jobs after school. Now is a critical time to get the state where it needs to be regarding financial aid access.
