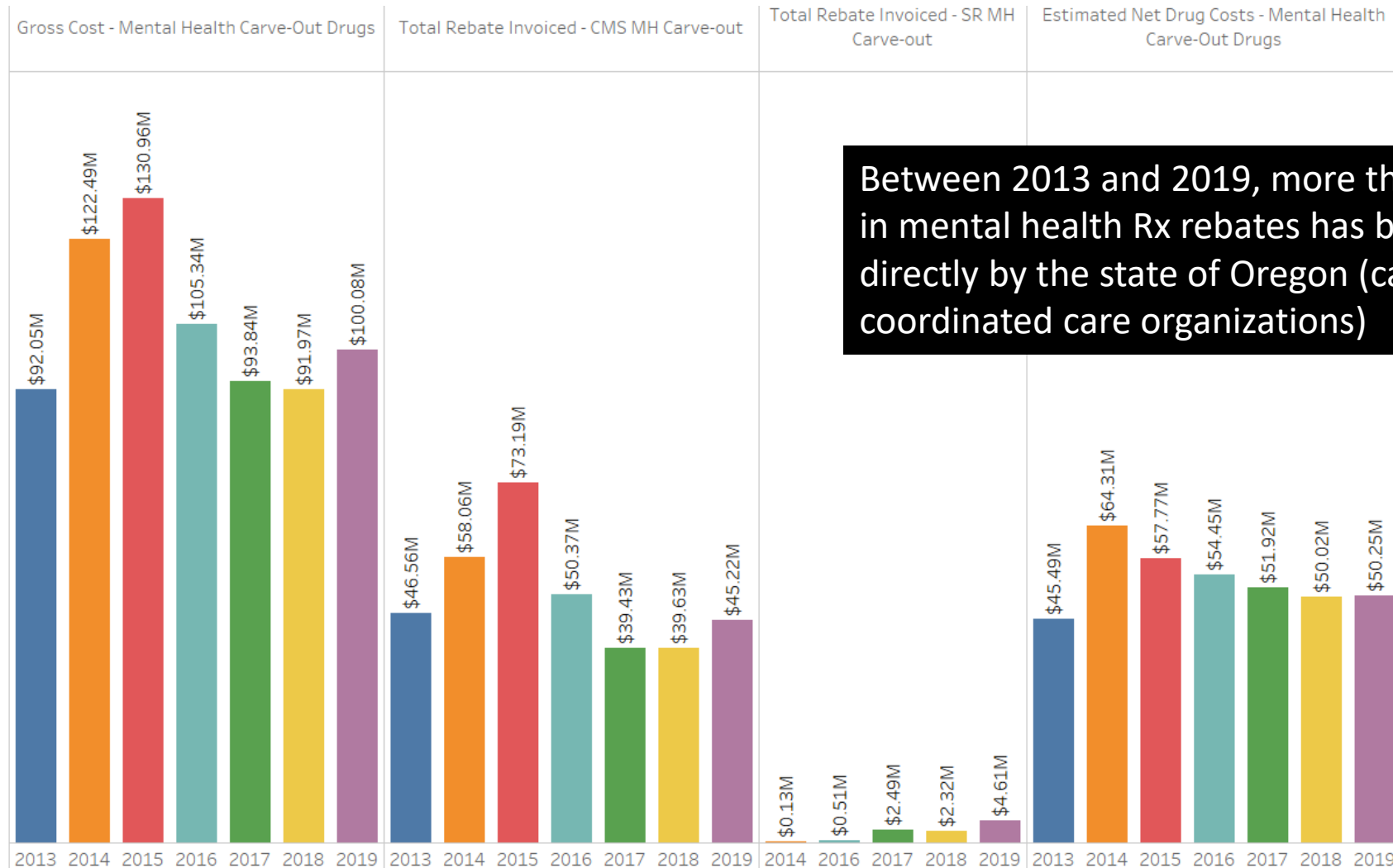


# Oregon Medicaid Mental Health Carve-Out Rx 2013 - 2019

Gross spending rose in 2019, but net spending was the same as 2018

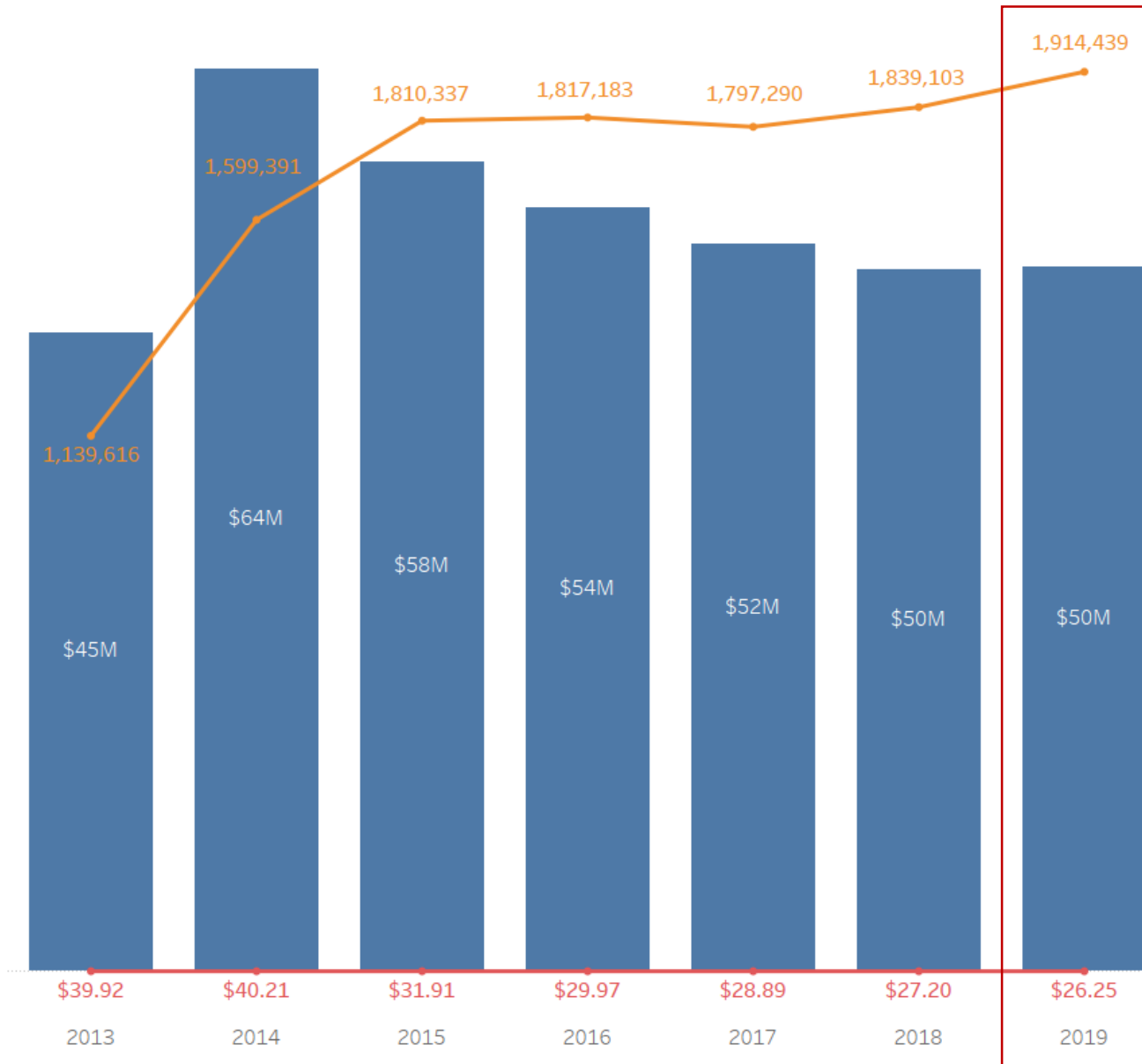


Between 2013 and 2019, more than \$360 million in mental health Rx rebates has been received directly by the state of Oregon (carved-out from coordinated care organizations)

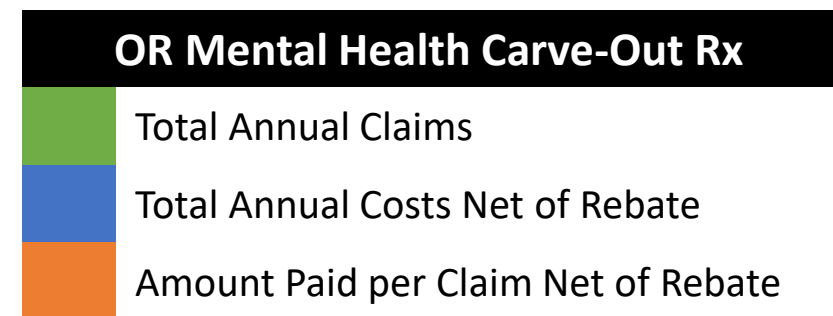

# MH Carve-Out Rx Real Costs are Down Significantly



- Net spending on MH carve-out drugs since 2013 is up 10%
- **However**, the **number of claims increased nearly 70%** between 2013 and 2019
- This means the state is getting more for less
- Notably, the average **amount paid per claim decreased by almost 35%**
