On behalf of the more than 6300 members of the American Association of University Professors in Oregon, our collective bargaining chapters at the University of Oregon, Portland State University, Oregon State University, and Oregon Institute of Technology, and our faculty members across Oregon, I ask that you **please support HB 2542-A**.

This Bill, supported by the Oregon Student Association, is clear and smart legislation ensuring we find multiple ways to support affordable tuition by addressing the adjacent growth in mandatory fees as tuition continually increases. Specifically, HB 2542-A will create statewide student access to mandatory fees, a step towards equity across the State for our students. In addition, we all need institutional accountability, transparency, and fiscal responsibility across all our institutions.
