Re: <u>HB 2440</u> Family Care Tax Credit - Support

The League supports a tax system that is based on the ability to pay, but that applies a benefitsreceived principle wherever reasonable and that recognizes the role of social expediency.

We support continuing the tax credit for working families with dependent care. The annual credit is worth about \$1000 per household for about 30,000 taxpayers in the bottom 60% income tax bracket according to Oregon Center for Public Policy. This is a big boost to families who most need financial help who are caring for loved ones.

The LWVOR recommends continuing the tax credit provision in this bill.
