Dear Chair Nathanson and members of the Committee:

I am testifying in support of 2357 because the Oregon Forest Resources Institute must not be in charge of providing the curriculum to our schools and to the public. OFRI's purpose is to lobby for Big Timber and it does this by attempting to silence scientific research, including that done at our own Oregon State University's Department of Forestry.
