The -A4 amendment is necessary to ensure that the public has access to police disciplinary records to protect citizens of our state from unchecked police misconduct. I believe that we are one of only nine states in the nation that keeps police misconduct records confidential. Without real transparency I fear that poliy abuses and wrongful convictions will persist as will the lack of trust between our communities and the police
