We have a really good thing going here.

to name a few of the projects I've worked on here. Imagine them being made somewhere else. Just this small sampling of what the incentive has helped bring to Oregon represents tens of millions of dollars spent on Props, Set Dressing, Security, Extras, Airplane tickets, Hotel Rooms, Caterers, Restaurants, Equipment rental, Costumes, ... I could go on and on and on. I hope we can.

Please **vote YES on SB43** to extend these critical programs for our local production industry. It supports my livelihood.
