Prohibits State Board of Education from requiring for high school diploma that student show proficiency in any academic content area if student successfully completed credit requirements. Applies to high school diplomas awarded on or after July 1, 2023. Declares emergency, effective on passage."

Excerpt from [SB 744 A] states, "Section 1...(4) When conducting the review and developing recommendations under this section, the department shall:... (a) Use a transparent process that is equitable, accessible and inclusive;... (A) <u>Representatives from historically</u> <u>underserved students, including students who</u>... (ii) Are from an immigrant or refugee population; (iii) <u>Are from racial or ethnic groups that</u> have historically experienced academic disparities;..."

Excerpt from [SB 744 A] states, "Section 1... (5) Notwithstanding any rules adopted by the State Board of Education, <u>a student may</u> not be required to show proficiency in Essential Learning Skills as a condition of receiving a high school diploma during the 2021-2022 or 2022-2023 school year."

Excerpt from [SB 744 A] states, "SECTION 3... (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, <u>the State Board of Education may</u> <u>not require</u> a student who has successfully completed the credit requirements prescribed by paragraph (a) of this subsection or by rule of the board to demonstrate <u>proficiency in any skill or academic content area.</u>"

Excerpt from [SB 744 A] states, "SECTION 5. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage. ***NOTE [SB 744 A] is declared an "Emergency" in 2021 but, The High School Classes of 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 are, "hung-out to dry...abandoned.. Socially promoted..."
