Terribly sad that boaters with heavy boats can't admit the harm they're doing and take serious action. In yesterdays hearings, many claimed that they wanted more science. If they want more science, then they need to pay for it and get it done. Quit talking about it as if it will just magically happen. It shouldn't be paid for by the folks who aren't doing any harm. Instead of hiring lobbyist, the boating community should put their money where their mouth is and pay for some studies. They might possibly resolve this issue and the handful of boaters who believe they aren't causing any harm can have the information they need to move on to a body of water that isn't so narrow.
