RE: Senate Bill 43 - Support

Dear Senators Burdick and Boquist and Representatives Nathanson and Pham:

I am writing on behalf of the Motion Picture Association – America (“MPA”) and our member companies\* to let you know of our support for Senate Bill 43, legislation to extend the sunset for incentives for film, television and streaming productions.

Oregon’s incentive programs, both the Greenlight Oregon Rebate Program and the tax credit program, contribute to the growth of the media sector within the state. In addition, these incentive programs have attracted out-of-state productions, that also contribute to Oregon’s economy, by hiring Oregon residents and purchasing goods and services from Oregon businesses that support production. As noted by the Northwest Economic Research Center, “state investment on production incentives is significantly outweighed by the economic activity that incentivized media production generates within the state.”
