Election day is the LAST DAY to receive a ballot (either by hand or in the mail). Changing this will cause slow downs in the results of an election being known until weeks after the actual election day. This also opens the whole system to fraud and mistakes by the post office to potentially alter our whole election processes.

This is too important of a constitutional right to allow to be opened up to the possibility of even more issues than it already has.
