If you're answer to being able to enjoy wakeboardimg, wake surfing or inner tuning you can always go someplace else is just pushing it to another area to then have over crowding and apparently no concern about erosion in those other areas.

The real problem is a few individuals who don't care for the sporting on the river. There are a few boaters who are not conscientious of others but the majority are safe and do right by home owners , kayakers, SUP, and fishing.

I think this is a blatant attack on those who not only live on the upper Willamette but those who come to the area.
