Wake boats change the dynamics of the entire river and need more space. These are the type of boats that will have to drive a little farther to recreate:









These are specialty craft designed for the sole purpose of creating large highenergy surf-like wakes, regardless of whether they're wake boarding or tubing.

Only 195 of these boats are recreating in the Newberg Pool.

The Water Sports Industry has repeatedly misrepresented the size and composition of our supporters by claiming that *"a small number of homeowners with special interests"…* This statement is intentionally misleading.
