Title: <u>HB 2104</u>, Child Welfare: Removing Barriers to Permanency

# **Concept:**

- Narrows the definition of "current caretaker" to be applicable when there is a permanency plan of adoption.
- Clarifies jurisdiction to prevent inadvertent termination of wardship by the state without proper safety considerations.

### Need for policy change:

The ODHS' Child Welfare Program (CW) has historically carried a significant backlog of pending adoption cases. CW is undergoing a review in partnership with Casey Family Programs to identify barriers and make improvements to reduce and/or eliminate the backlog.

### **History:**

- <u>SB 741 (2015)</u> established the current caretaker definition and was intended to give relatives and current caretakers equal status when being considered as prospective adoptive parents.
- Jurisdictional issues have arisen in wardship cases resulting in immediate termination without proper safety considerations.
