

This bill proposes to provide a cure for a problem that does not exist.

This bill does nothing to restrict any criminal element, but only places an onerous burden upon law-abiding citizens.

By placing burdensome and onerous restrictions on the rights of law-abiding citizens, this bill violates the constitutional rights of all law-abiding citizens. These are the very same rights that all state legislators have sworn to uphold and protect.

I urge you to not let this bill out of committee. If it does make it out of committee, I strongly urge you to properly exercise your constitutional oaths and vote NO on this heinous legislation.
