RE: Follow-up Testimony on SB 106

Co-Chairs Beyer and McLain, Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on SB 106. We would like to provide additional information to answer questions from the hearing.

### Classes of ATV

Class I: Quads or three-wheelers

Class II: Jeeps, Trucks

Class III: Motorcycles



Class IV: Side-by-Sides



### Section 2 language including 5 years of experience.

Section 2 of SB 106 provides an option for adults with five years of Class IV riding experience to obtain a safety education card without taking the safety education course. This option is currently allowed for adult riders in other classes. Through the online system, riders have the option of selecting they would like to take the test without first completing the course. If they pass the test, they will receive the card. This option was included to recognize the knowledge of existing riders while implementing the new requirement.

For individuals without access to the internet, written materials and a paper copy of the test may be requested.

Every two years, OPRD's ATV program holds a workshop with law enforcement partners to discuss safety and enforcement issues and make suggestions for laws or rules that should be addressed. SB 106 was developed based on recommendations from that workshop in consultation with the All-Terrain Vehicle Advisory Committee (ORS 390.565).
