My name is Arlette Tapia Lopez and I am a sophomore at Western Oregon University studying Criminal Justice.

I am writing today to ask you to vote yes on HB 2524, which would create mandatory fee transparency at all public colleges.

This term in addition to tuition, textbooks and living expenses, I have paid \$3,376 in fees. At the beginning of the term I didn't know where the fees were going towards prior to the term. All of the fees were unclear, one of those being the online fee which is a new fee that was added this academic school year at WOU. Administration has failed to elaborate on where the fee is going towards. Whereas students should be able to have access to a concrete layout to where their money is going towards.

After multiple attempts on trying to reach out to administration to get a response where the fees are going towards and on how the fees are being distributed for the students needs. Administration has failed to give students a clear response. It has been difficult for students at WOU to get in contact with administration.
