Especially this year, with the effects of a pandemic, and devastating fires, businesses don't need new taxes on top of an already struggling economy. The legislature already imposed a new corporate sales tax this year, during a pandemic, even though the voters overwhelmingly opposed the same ballot measure in the previous election. Where is the representation of the people? Any new tax (like the CAT tax just imposed) will be passed through for consumers to pay. Why do lawmakers not understand this? A new severance tax will drive up the cost of building materials and wood products even more, making housing less affordable for all Oregonians. Please don't pile on a new tax for struggling businesses and industries. It's going to eliminate jobs and will be the beginning of downfall, getting worse and worse until it can no longer exist. Increasing taxes and hurting businesses will lead to less overall revenue collected - don't kill the golden goose.
