Chair Witt and members of the committee,

My name is Amy Patrick and I represent the Oregon Hunters Association. The Oregon Hunters Association supports HB2067 as it is currently written. We support the department's ability to have flexible fees for licenses and tags that would be less than or equal to the fee structure laid out in statute.

As the department looks at ways to retain the marked increase in tag and license sales in 2020 due to the "covid contingent", the ability to broaden marketing opportunities would greatly enhance their work toward the nationally recognized "R3" mission of recruitment, retention, and reactivation.

Our only concern would be any significant financial impact to the department, however that does not appear to be the case with this bill as it is currently written.
