Public Hearing

HB 4012

(1:05 pm) Directs DHS to review child welfare service provider rate structure and submit report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly on or before February 28, 2023.

HB 4088

(1:30 pm) Requires DHS to develop plan to implement SNAP restaurant meals program in OR and report back to legislature.

AGENDA (cont.) February 3, 2022

HB 4117

(1:55 pm) Requires DHS to adopt by rule a grant program to provide funding to culturally specific and responsive organizations, tribal govs, and under-resourced rural community service orgs to conduct outreach re EITC and other tax benefits and provide tax navigation and preparation services to low-income ORS.

HB 4093

(2:20 pm) Directs DAS to calculate genuine progress indicator to measure economic and social welfare. Directs department to report on indicator to Legislative Assembly and GOV.

Register to testify live remotely:

- Registration is required to testify by phone or video.

- Unless otherwise noted on the agenda, testimony is only accepted by committees for bills or topics scheduled for a public hearing. See the Oregon Legislature's website for information on contacting individual legislators directly on bills or topics not scheduled for a public hearing
