Work Session

HB 4021

Extends period in which taxpayers, upon transfer of ownership of homestead or moving manufactured structure or floating home out of state, may discontinue participation in homestead property tax deferral program in assessment year.

HB 4115

Directs Oregon Investment Council to publish annually complete list of assets held in investment funds.

HB 4054

Limits program for property tax special assessment of historic property to commercial property.

HB 4055

Extends privilege taxes on merchantable forest products harvested on forestlands.

Public Hearing

HB 4043

Creates credit against income taxes for purchasing publicly supported housing to retain as affordable housing.

HB 4097

Establishes income tax credit for volunteer firefighters.
