Work Session

HB 4035 A

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study and make recommendations for options to improve access to or lower cost of health care in Oregon.

HB 4107

Directs Legislative Policy and Research Director to study use of impact statements in legislative deliberations and to report findings to Legislative Policy and Research Committee on or before February 1, 2023.

HB 4114

Requires members of district school board for common school district or union high school district to file verified statement of economic interest with Oregon Government Ethics Commission.

HB 4138

Amends provisions of workers' compensation law related to payments of benefits, notice to workers, recovery of overpayments and errors in claims processing.

HB 4157

Directs Department of Revenue to establish and administer program to provide one-time assistance payments to low-income households to address negative economic impacts of COVID-19 public health emergency.
