(8:40 am) Directs Department of Transportation to study establishment of bistate Hood River bridge commission and report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to transportation on or before September 15, 2023.

HB 4090

(9:10 am) Requires state contracting agency that procures or intends to procure vehicle with diesel motor or engine to qualify vehicle for procurement by obtaining certification from manufacturer or vendor of vehicle that diesel motor or engine is capable of operating with blended fuel that consists of not less than 20 percent biodiesel.

- Registration closes one hour before the meeting is scheduled to begin.
- A public access kiosk is at the Capitol Building for anyone without access to a phone or computer to join a meeting by video.
- Neither registration nor use of the public access kiosk is a guarantee that you will be able to testify during the meeting. Committee chairs may determine that public testimony must be limited. For this reason, written testimony is encouraged even if you plan to speak.
- Unless otherwise noted on the agenda, testimony is only accepted by committees for bills or topics scheduled for a public hearing. See the Oregon Legislature's website for information on contacting individual legislators directly on bills or topics not scheduled for a public hearing.
