SB 1518

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02-09-2022 MEETING: Adds Reach Code to state building code as specialty code and gives power of administration and interpretation of Reach Code to Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services.

SB 1567

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02-09-2022 MEETING: Requires owners or operators of bulk oils and liquid fuels terminals to conduct and submit to Department of Environmental Quality seismic vulnerability assessments.

SB 1589

Provides that maximum loading weight of motorboat must be less than 5,000 pounds to obtain towed watersports motorboat certificate.

Note change: SB 1518 and SB 1567 have been carried over.
