- Registration closes one hour before the meeting is scheduled to begin.
- A public access kiosk is at the Capitol Building for anyone without access to a phone or computer to join a meeting by video.
- Neither registration nor use of the public access kiosk is a guarantee that you will be able to testify during the meeting. Committee chairs may determine that public testimony must be limited. For this reason, written testimony is encouraged even if you plan to speak.
- Unless otherwise noted on the agenda, testimony is only accepted by committees for bills or topics scheduled for a public hearing. See the Oregon Legislature's website for information on

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contacting individual legislators directly on bills or topics not scheduled for a public hearing.
