Possible Work Session

HB 4105 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-21-2022 MEETING: Authorizes duly authorized traffic enforcement agents to review and issue citations based on photographs taken by photo red light cameras or photographs taken by photo radar cameras.

HB 4120

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-21-2022 MEETING: Authorizes court to waive minimum fine in violation proceedings in certain circumstances.

HB 4121

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-21-2022 MEETING: Authorizes presiding judge of judicial district to appoint child support referee to process or hear certain child support or parentage matters.
