Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 1537

Modifies requirements for housing cost impact statement required for adoption of certain rules. HB 4008 A

Authorizes Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline to hire executive director and support staff, and to enter into interagency or intergovernmental agreement for provision of support staff.

HB 4016 A

Authorizes Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to, based on supply of and demand for marijuana, refuse to issue initial marijuana production, processing, wholesale and retail licenses for amount of time commission determines necessary.

HB 4061 A

Requires certain water suppliers to maintain certain records for at least 12 months and provide records to law enforcement or Water Resources Department upon request.

HB 4062 A

Establishes noncommercial pesticide applicator license and noncommercial pesticide trainee's certificate.

HB 4096 A

Authorizes health care practitioner authorized in another state or United States territory to practice in this state without compensation for specified number of days without obtaining licensure in this state.

HB 4134 A

Requires insurer and health care service contractor to cover labor and delivery services provided at out-of-network health care facility if services provided at out-of-network facility due solely to diversion of patient from in-network health care facility for reasons related to state or federal declaration of public health emergency.

HB 4153

Directs Oregon Film and Video Office to establish Creative Opportunity Program to promote film, television, interactive, animation and media industries in Oregon.

HCR 204

Recognizes and honors Sergeant John Noble Holcomb (1946-1968) for his service to his country.

- Neither registration nor use of the public access kiosk is a guarantee that you will be able to testify during the meeting. Committee chairs may determine that public testimony must be limited. For this reason, written testimony is encouraged even if you plan to speak.
- Unless otherwise noted on the agenda, testimony is only accepted by committees for bills or topics scheduled for a public hearing. See the Oregon Legislature's website for information on contacting individual legislators directly on bills or topics not scheduled for a public hearing.
