SUBJECT: February 1, 2022 Meeting – LC Summaries

- LC 283 Requires Governor to appoint United States Senator when vacancy in office occurs. Establishes that person appointed be a citizen qualified to hold office and be affiliated with the same political party as elected Senator who vacated office. Makes appointment expire when term of office ends or successor is elected at next general election to occur 61 or more days after vacancy, whichever comes first.
- LC 286 Allows identified election workers to have residence address exempted from disclosure as public record by county clerk. Defines election worker as individual serving the state or any public body as an employee or volunteer who is performing duties and functions described in Oregon's elections statutes. Establishes that crime of harassment or aggravated harassment includes harassment against election worker. Punishes by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
- LC 295 Modifies composition and duties, powers, and functions of Oregon Cybersecurity Advisory Council as governing body of Oregon Cybersecurity Center of Excellence (Center). Establishes Center as independent, nonprofit public corporation charged with overseeing, coordinating, funding, and providing cybersecurity education, awareness, and training for public, private, and nonprofit sectors, cybersecurity workforce development, and cybersecurity-related goods and services to Oregon public bodies. Directs Portland State University, Oregon State University, and University of Oregon to jointly operate Center by agreement and to provide facilities and administrative and staff support. Establishes targeted funds to carry out Center functions and operations. Becomes operative July 1, 2022. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
- LC 296 Recognizes and honors Sergeant John Noble Holcomb (1946-1968) for his service to his country.
