MECHANICAL BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Mechanical Board subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of ten members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.⁴ Membership must include:

- One representative of the plumbing industry (SCHEUERMANN).
- One sheet metal and air conditioner contractor (MILLER).
- One municipal mechanical inspector possessing the highest level of mechanical inspector certification issued by the Department of Consumer and Business Services (VACANT).
- One heating, venting, and air conditioning contractor (HANSEN).
- One heating, venting, and air conditioning installer (FANNING).
- One sheet metal and air conditioner installer (FRAZIER).
- One representative of a natural gas company or other utility (KENNEDY).
- One building official (ZUK).

- One insulation craftsperson who has experience with heat and frost insulation (CAUDLE).
- One public member who does not receive compensation from any interest represented by another member of the board (HILL).

At least one of the contractor members must be an owner or operator of a contracting business employing 10 or fewer persons at the time of the member's appointment to the term.

Members serve four-year terms and are not eligible for appointment to more than two full terms in office. Members serve at the pleasure of the Governor, and the Governor may remove a board member for good cause including three unexcused absences during any 12-month period from a regularly scheduled board meeting.

A majority of the members of a board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business. The board must meet at least twice per year at times and places specified by the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services after consultation with the board, or at times and places specified by the call of a majority of the members of the board after consultation with the director.⁵

Duties and Authority

The board assists the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services in administering the installation code for mechanical devices and equipment.⁶ The board must:⁷

- before the director notices rulemaking for the adoption, amendment, or repeal of the Mechanical Specialty Code, find that the added cost, if any, is necessary to the health and safety of the occupants or the public or necessary to conserve scarce resources;
- review and report to the director recommendations for amendments to the Mechanical Specialty Code;
- approve technical and scientific facts related to proposed material, design, or method of construction;
- approve alternative regulatory options for emerging technologies;
- receive and adjudicate appeals of suspected code violations, building official decisions, and municipal appeals board decisions;
- approve the adoption and amendment of the Mechanical Specialty Code;
- approve the adoption of rules the director considers necessary to interpret, harmonize, streamline, adjust, promote consistency within, reduce confusion regarding, administer, or enforce the state building code;
- consult with the director regarding alternative permit and inspection programs, including a statewide permitting and inspection program for minor construction work;
- select two members to serve on the Construction Industry Energy Board;

- consult with the director on the adoption of uniform energy conservation standards and the Reach Code; and
- advise the director on standards, qualifications, and training for building officials and inspectors.

The board may impose civil penalties for violations of the Mechanical Specialty Code.8
