## HEALTH EVIDENCE REVIEW COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Health Evidence Review Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

### New Appointee

Ben Hoffman of Portland

### Term

March 1, 2022 – February 28, 2026

### Appointment/Confirmation Authority

### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

### Statutory Requirements<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of 13 members appointed by the Governor in consultation with professional and other interested organizations and confirmed by the Senate.<sup>4</sup>

- Five members must be physicians licensed to practice medicine in this state who have clinical expertise in the areas of family medicine (KAISER), internal medicine (KANSAGARA, OLSON), obstetrics (**HOFFMAN**), perinatal health, pediatrics, disabilities, geriatrics, or general surgery (SCHABEL). One of the physicians must be a doctor of osteopathic medicine, and one must be a hospital representative or a physician whose practice is significantly hospital-based.
- One member must be a licensed dentist who has clinical expertise in general, pediatric, or public health dentistry (GEISLER).
- One member must be a public health nurse (PINZON).
- One member must be a behavioral health representative who may be a social services worker, alcohol and drug treatment provider, psychologist or psychiatrist (LINDSEY).

- Two members must be consumers of health care who are patient advocates or represent the areas of indigent services, labor, business, education, or corrections (COLLINS, SUTTON).
- One member must be a complementary or alternative medicine provider who is a licensed chiropractic physician, a licensed naturopathic physician, or a licensed acupuncturist (ESPESETE).
- One member must be an insurance industry representative who may be a medical director or other administrator (HODGES).
- One member must be a pharmacy representative who engages in the practice of pharmacy at a retail drug outlet (IRWIN).

No more than six members of the commission may be physicians either in active practice or retired from practice. Members serve four-year terms and at the pleasure of the Governor. The commission must select one of its members as chairperson and another as vice chairperson, for terms and with duties and powers the commission determines necessary for the performance of the functions of the offices.<sup>5</sup>

## **Duties and Authority**

The commission develops and maintains a prioritized list of health services which are reported to the Oregon Health Authority, Legislative Assembly, and the Governor.<sup>6</sup> In completing this work, the commission must:

- regularly solicit testimony and information from stakeholders representing consumers, advocates, providers, carriers, and employers in conducting the work of the commission;
- actively solicit public involvement through a public meeting process to guide health resource allocation decisions;
- consider both the clinical effectiveness and cost effectiveness of health services, including drug therapies, in determining their relative importance using peer-reviewed medical literature;
- develop and administer a medical technology assessment process to evaluate the effectiveness of research of medical technologies; and
- consult with an advisory committee in determining priorities for mental health care and chemical dependency.
