WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Modifies statutory provisions relating to the Tribal Early Learning Hub. Specifically, the measure makes the member from the Commission on Indian Affairs a non-voting member and eliminates the parent members. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

FISCAL: No fiscal impact

REVENUE: No revenue impact

House: Third reading. Carried by Reynolds. Passed. Ayes, 37; Nays, 19.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Government-to-government relationships between State of Oregon and federally recognized tribes
- Needs of tribal communities
- Needs of parents

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon currently has 16 regional early learning hubs to coordinate local systems for the delivery of early learning in their regions. In 2021, the Legislative Assembly enacted House Bill 2055, creating the Tribal Early Learning Hub. House Bill 4033 modifies the membership provisions establishing the Tribal Early Learning Hub.
