- Well-checks for isolated or homebound individuals
- Behavioral health support for responders and the public
- Call-center staffing
- Mass casualty triage
- Healthcare training facilitation





Appropriate Mission Types for SERV-OR Support

- Medical Rapid Response Team (MRRT)
 - A 12-person team of mixed clinician types
- Hazard-specific missions, including:
 - Extreme Temperature Events
 - Mass Violence
 - Earthquakes
 - Communicable Disease or Bioterrorism

Savings of SERV-OR Volunteers

- Cost Saving Methods
 - HHS federal grant funds can be matched by hourly volunteer contributions
 - The value of a volunteer hour is on average \$28.54 per hour
 - Low administrative coordination overhead
- Hourly Savings
 - Most SERV-OR volunteers are Registered Nurses
 - In 2020, SERV-OR volunteers contributed 9,272.80 hours of emergency volunteer service.
- Efficiency and Mission Flexibility
 - Volunteers can fill intermittent and small mission assignments
