Subject: SB 1520 – Relating to Oregon's program for redemption of beverage container refund values.
Work Session Recommendations

The measure requires distributors that sold more than 500,000 beverages in the state within the previous calendar year and do not participate in a distributor cooperative to establish a program to provide redemption services comparable to services provided by a distributive cooperative in the state. Proposes a fee to be paid to OLCC, under certain circumstances, by distributors that are not members of a distributor's cooperative. The measure also requires a deposit to be paid on wines sold in cans and requires OLCC to develop and provide notices to be displayed by dealers

Recommended Changes

The -A4 provides \$101,426 Other Funds limitation increase for administration and coordination of bottle redemption activities.

LFO recommends adoption of the -A4 amendment.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that SB 1520, as amended by the -A4 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
