## SB 1510 Relating to public safety

SB 1510 outlines requirements for police officers when commencing a traffic stop, effective January 1, 2023. The measure also appropriates \$10 million of one-time General Fund to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for distribution to the Northwest Health Foundation Fund II to fund a Justice Reinvestment Equity Program and decreases the corresponding special purpose appropriation made to the Emergency Board for a Transforming Justice Initiative by \$10 million.

The NW Health Foundation Fund will provide subgrants and technical assistance to culturally specific organizations and culturally responsive service providers. The measure provides \$200,000 of one-time General Fund for a third-party contract to evaluate the Equity Program. CJC will monitor the progress of subgrants provided by the Fund and provide a report to the Legislature on the program by September 30, 2024.

The -A7 amendment provides an additional \$421,857 General Fund to CJC for three permanent full-time positions and associated costs for administering this measure.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends SB 1510 be amended by the –A7 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
