SUMMARY

Allows identified election worker to have residence address exempted from disclosure as public record by county clerk.

Establishes that crime of harassment or aggravated harassment includes harassment against election worker. Punishes by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure allows an election worker to have the election worker's residence address exempted from public disclosure by the county clerk.

These public records are currently subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, unless another exemption from disclosure applies.
