House Bill 4031

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Education for Department of Education)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes state goal that percentage of diverse employees employed by Department of Education reflects percentage of diverse students in public schools.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to diversity goals in education; amending ORS 342.437, 342.447, 342.448 and 348.295.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 342.437 is amended to read:

5 342.437. (1) As a result of this state's commitment to equality for the diverse peoples of this 6 state, the [goal] goals of the state [is] are that:

7 (a) The percentage of diverse educators employed by a school district or an education service 8 district reflects the percentage of diverse students in the public schools of this state or the per-9 centage of diverse students in the district.

(b) The percentage of diverse employees employed by the Department of Education re flects the percentage of diverse students in the public schools of this state.

12 (2) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the Educator Advancement Council, shall 13 use federal reports on educator equity to monitor school district and education service district 14 progress on meeting the goal described in subsection [(1)] (1)(a) of this section, in relation to the 15 recruitment, hiring and retention of diverse educators.

16 **SECTION 2.** ORS 342.447 is amended to read:

17 342.447. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall require each public educator 18 preparation program in this state to prepare a plan with specific goals, strategies and deadlines for 19 the recruitment, admission, retention and graduation of diverse educators to accomplish the goal 20 described in ORS 342.437 (1)(a).

(2) The commission shall review the plans for adequacy and feasibility with the governing board
of each public university with an educator preparation program and, after necessary revisions are
made, shall adopt the plans.

- 24 (3) The commission shall provide guidance on:
- 25 (a) The contents of the plans;

(b) The commission's initial and biennial review process, including timetables for revising plans;and

(c) Other matters necessary for carrying out the provisions of ORS 342.433 to 342.449 and
350.100.

31 342.448. (1) Representatives of the Educator Advancement Council, the Higher Education Coor-

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dinating Commission, the Department of Education and the Teacher Standards and Practices Com-1

2 mission shall jointly create a report on the Educators Equity Act. The report shall be created in consultation with educator preparation providers and shall include: 3

(a) A summary of the most recent data collected as provided by ORS 342.443 (1)(d) to (h). 4

5 (b) A summary of the plans currently implemented as provided by ORS 342.447.

(c) A review of the goal described in ORS 342.437 (1)(a), including: 6

(A) Determination of the need for additional related state goals. 7

(B) Progress made by the state toward meeting the goal described in ORS 342.437 (1)(a) and any 8 9 other additional related state goals.

(C) Recommendations and a long-term plan for meeting the goal described in ORS 342.437 (1)(a) 10 and any other additional related state goals. 11

12 (d) A description of best practices within this state and other states for recruiting, hiring and 13retaining diverse educators.

(e) Recommendations for legislation to help the state meet the goal described in ORS 342.437 14 15(1)(a) and any other additional related state goals.

16 (2)(a) The report created as provided by subsection (1) of this section shall be submitted:

(A) To the interim legislative committees on education by September 1 of each even-numbered 17 year; and 18

19 (B) To the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 by September 1 of each 20even-numbered year.

(b) The report submitted as required by paragraph (a)(B) of this subsection shall be submitted 2122with the data reported as required by ORS 342.443 (1)(d) to (h).

23(3) The Educator Advancement Council, the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, the Department of Education and the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission shall make the re-24port submitted as provided under subsection (2) of this section available on the website of each 2526agency.

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SECTION 4. ORS 348.295 is amended to read:

348.295. (1) In addition to any other form of student financial aid authorized by law, the Higher 28Education Coordinating Commission may award scholarships to culturally and linguistically diverse 2930 teacher candidates to use at approved educator preparation providers, as defined in ORS 342.120, for 31 the purpose of advancing the goal described in ORS 342.437 (1)(a).

(2) Scholarships awarded under this section shall be in amounts of \$10,000 each academic year, 32for a maximum of two academic years. 33

34 (3) The commission shall adopt rules necessary for the implementation and administration of this section in consultation with the Educator Advancement Council and the Department of Education. 35

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
