

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4102

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “persons” insert “; and prescribing an effective date”.

2 Delete lines 15 through 19 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 3. No later than October 31, 2022, the Board on Public Safety Standards and**
4 **Training shall provide, in a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative**
5 **Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245, an operational plan for the provision**
6 **of training for police officers concerning the investigation and reporting of cases involving**
7 **missing or murdered indigenous persons in this state. The plan must identify the method and**
8 **cost of delivery, and the anticipated number of training hours, of the training.**

9 **“SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2022 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2023.**

10 **“SECTION 5. This 2022 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2022**
11 **regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”**
