

# Senate Bill 1523

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to conduct study related to impact of 2020 wildfires on state school funding distributions.

Sunsets July 31, 2022.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to school finance; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Legislative Revenue Officer shall conduct a study to determine the**  
5 **impact of the 2020 wildfires on state school funding that is based on school attendance and**  
6 **to develop potential solutions for any related decreases in state school funding distributions**  
7 **to school districts.**

8 **(2) The officer shall report the results of the study to an interim committee of the Leg-**  
9 **islative Assembly related to education no later than June 1, 2022.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2022 Act is repealed on July 31, 2022.**

11 **SECTION 3. This 2022 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2022 Act takes effect**  
13 **on its passage.**
