

# A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5702

Ordered by the Senate March 1  
Including Senate Amendments dated March 1

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

**Establishes and modifies limits on payment of expenses from specified funds by certain state agencies for capital construction.**  
**Appropriates moneys from General Fund to specified state agencies for capital construction.**  
**Approves sale of Silverton Armory.**  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; creating new provisions; amending sections 1 and 3, chapter 659, Oregon Laws 2021; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 1, chapter 659, Oregon Laws 2021, is amended to read:

**Sec. 1.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the state agencies listed, for the acquisition of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of buildings and facilities:

- (1) Oregon Department of Administrative Services:
  - (a) Deferred Maintenance ..... \$ 15,500,000
  - (b) Gender Neutral Facilities and Mothers' Rooms..... \$ 10,000,000
  - (c) Capitol Mall Parking Structure Improvements ..... \$ 2,750,000
  - (d) Dome Building and Yaquina Hall Improvements..... \$ 1,500,000
  - (e) Climate Adaptation and Net Zero Solutions..... \$ 2,000,000
  - (f) Parking Lot Improvements
