**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4074**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “section 13,” and insert  
2 “sections 13, 14 and 16,” and after the semicolon insert “repealing sections  
3 17 and 26, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018;”.

4 On page 3, after line 42, insert:

5 **“SECTION 10.** Section 16, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, as amended  
6 by section 39, chapter 542, Oregon Laws 2021, is amended to read:

7 **“Sec. 16.** [(1)] Notwithstanding ORS [475B.759] **475C.726**, before making  
8 any other distribution from the Oregon Marijuana Account established under  
9 ORS [475B.759] **475C.726**, the Department of Revenue shall first distribute  
10 quarterly from the account the following:

11 “[a] (1) \$875,000 to the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission for  
12 deposit in the Marijuana Control and Regulation Fund established under  
13 ORS [475B.296] **475C.297**; and

14 “[b] (2) \$750,000 to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for deposit  
15 into the Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program Fund estab-  
16 lished under section 15, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, for the purposes of  
17 paying the costs incurred by the commission in carrying out the provisions  
18 of section 13, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018.

19 “[2] *The final distribution made under subsection (1) of this section shall*  
20 *be made in the fiscal quarter beginning on October 1, 2023.*]

21 **“SECTION 11.** Section 16, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, as amended

1 by section 39, chapter 542, Oregon Laws 2021, and section 10 of this 2022 Act,  
2 is amended to read:

3 “**Sec. 16.** Notwithstanding ORS 475C.726, before making any other dis-  
4 tribution from the Oregon Marijuana Account established under ORS  
5 475C.726, the Department of Revenue shall first distribute quarterly from the  
6 account the following:

7 “(1) \$875,000 to the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission for deposit  
8 in the Marijuana Control and Regulation Fund established under ORS  
9 475C.297; *[and]*

10 “[*(2) \$750,000 to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for deposit into*  
11 *the Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program Fund established*  
12 *under section 15, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, for the purposes of paying*  
13 *the costs incurred by the commission in carrying out the provisions of section*  
14 *13, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018.]*

15 “(2) **\$3,250,000 to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for de-**  
16 **posit into the Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program**  
17 **Fund established under section 15, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, for**  
18 **the purposes of paying the costs incurred by the commission in**  
19 **awarding grants to law enforcement agencies under section 13, chapter**  
20 **103, Oregon Laws 2018; and**

21 “(3) **\$750,000 to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for deposit**  
22 **into the Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program Fund**  
23 **established under section 15, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, for the**  
24 **purposes of paying the costs incurred by the commission in awarding**  
25 **grants to community-based organizations under section 13, chapter**  
26 **103, Oregon Laws 2018.**

27 “**SECTION 12. The amendments to section 16, chapter 103, Oregon**  
28 **Laws 2018, by section 11 of this 2022 Act become operative on July 1,**  
29 **2023.**

30 “**SECTION 13. Section 14, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, is amended to**

1 read:

2 “**Sec. 14. (1)** [*Not later than January 1, 2020, and*] Not later than January  
3 1 **of** each year [*thereafter*], the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall  
4 submit a report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 on the status and  
5 effectiveness of the Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program  
6 established under section 13 [*of this 2018 Act*], **chapter 103, Oregon Laws**  
7 **2018**, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the  
8 judiciary.

9 “**(2) Not later than January 1 of each year, the commission shall**  
10 **submit, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the interim com-**  
11 **mittees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary, a report**  
12 **on recommendations for changes to the funding of the Illegal**  
13 **Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program. In making the rec-**  
14 **ommendations described in this subsection, the commission shall**  
15 **consider the best available information and projections regarding un-**  
16 **lawful marijuana cultivation and distribution operations in this state**  
17 **and any human trafficking related to those operations.**

18 “**SECTION 14. Sections 17 and 26, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018,**  
19 **are repealed.”.**

20 In line 43, delete “10” and insert “15”.

21 On page 4, after line 3, insert:

22 “**SECTION 16. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
23 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 3, chapter 379,**  
24 **Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the max-**  
25 **imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-**  
26  **nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds**  
27 **and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice**  
28 **Commission, is increased by \$4,500,000 for financial assistance to**  
29 **community-based organizations for the purposes described in section**  
30 **13, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018.”.**

1 In line 4, delete “11” and insert “17”.

2 In line 11, delete “12” and insert “18”.

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
