## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1573

1 Delete lines 9 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>"SECTION 2.</u> (1) Moneys appropriated to the State Forestry Department under section 1 of this 2022 Act shall be used to conduct
forest thinning operations in Baker, Clackamas, Coos, Crook, Curry,
Deschutes, Douglas, Grant, Harney, Hood River, Jackson, Jefferson,
Josephine, Klamath, Lake, Lane, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Morrow,
Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Wasco and Wheeler Counties.

8 "(2) The department shall allocate the amount appropriated to the 9 department equally among all of the counties listed in subsection (1) 10 of this subsection to fund forest thinning operations on public lands 11 in each county. The department shall confer with the governing body 12 for each county to determine specific forest thinning operations to be 13 conducted, so that:

"(a) Amounts may be used to directly fund department operations
 on state lands located in a county to conduct forest thinning; and
 "(b) The remaining balance of moneys may be used to fund county
 governing body efforts to increase forest thinning operations on public
 lands within that county.".
