**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4096**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after “683.030,” insert “684.107,”.

2 In line 15, delete “and”.

3 Delete line 16 and insert:

4 “(F) State Board of Chiropractic Examiners; and

5 “(G) State Board of Pharmacy.”.

6 On page 6, after line 20, insert:

7 **“SECTION 7. ORS 684.107 is amended to read:**

8 “684.107. A person licensed to practice chiropractic under the laws of  
9 another state is exempt from the licensure requirement in ORS 684.020 if  
10 [*that*] **the** person:

11 “(1)(a) Is practicing in Oregon on a single, temporary assignment for a  
12 specific sporting, performing arts or educational event not to exceed 15 days;  
13 and

14 “[~~(2)~~] (b) Is actively engaged in the practice of chiropractic in the state  
15 in which the person is licensed[.]; **or**

16 **“(2) Is practicing under section 1 of this 2022 Act.”.**

17 In line 21, delete “7” and insert “8”.

18 On page 7, line 1, delete “8” and insert “9”.

19 Delete lines 28 through 39 and insert:

20 **“SECTION 10. (1) Section 1 of this 2022 Act and the amendments to  
21 ORS 677.137, 678.031, 679.025, 680.020, 683.030, 684.107, 685.030 and 689.225**

1 by sections 2 to 9 of this 2022 Act become operative on January 1, 2023.

2 “(2) The Oregon Board of Dentistry, the Oregon Board of  
3 Naturopathic Medicine, the Oregon Board of Optometry, the Oregon  
4 Medical Board, the Oregon State Board of Nursing, the State Board  
5 of Chiropractic Examiners and the State Board of Pharmacy may take  
6 any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this  
7 section that is necessary to enable the boards to exercise, on and after  
8 the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the  
9 duties, functions and powers conferred on the boards by section 1 of  
10 this 2022 Act and the amendments to ORS 677.137, 678.031, 679.025,  
11 680.020, 683.030, 684.107, 685.030 and 689.225 by sections 2 to 9 of this 2022  
12 Act.

13 “SECTION 11. This 2022 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the  
14 date on which the 2022 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative  
15 Assembly adjourns sine die.”.
