PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1564

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

3 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

4 "(a) 'Grow site' has the meaning given that term by the State De5 partment of Agriculture by rule.

"(b) 'Industrial hemp' has the meaning given that term in ORS
571.269.

8 "(c) 'Research grower license' has the meaning given that term by
9 the department by rule.

"(2)(a) The governing body of a county that, pursuant to ORS 10 401.309, declares a state of emergency related to cannabis may notify 11 the State Department of Agriculture of the declaration and request 12 that the department deny the issuance of grower licenses under ORS 13 571.281, including to applicants that submitted applications for grower 14 licenses under ORS 571.281 on or after January 1, 2022, and prior to the 15effective date of this 2022 Act, for grow sites located in an area subject 16 to the jurisdiction of the county. 17

"(b) A declaration of a state of emergency described in paragraph
(a) of this subsection must:

"(A) Be for a duration that includes the entire growing season for
 industrial hemp, as determined by the department; and

"(B) Include a statement that denying the issuance of grower li censes under ORS 571.281 as described in paragraph (a) of this sub section may alleviate the conditions giving rise to the declaration.

4 "(c) The notification described in paragraph (a) of this subsection
5 must be:

"(A) Made annually for each year during which the governing body
of a county declares a state of emergency as described in paragraph
(a) of this subsection; and

9 "(B) Received by the department:

"(i) Not later than March 15, 2022, for the 2022 growing season; and
"(ii) Not later than January 1, 2023, for the 2023 growing season.

"(3) When the department receives the notice and request described 12 in this section, the department shall deny the issuance of grower li-13 censes under ORS 571.281 as described in subsection (2) of this section. 14 "(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3) of this section, the department 15 may issue a grower license under ORS 571.281 for a grow site located 16 in an area subject to the jurisdiction of a county described in sub-17 section (2) of this section if the applicant held a valid grower license 18 or registration under ORS 571.281 during the 2020 or 2021 calendar year. 19

20 "(5) The department may adopt rules to carry out this section.

21 "(6) This section does not apply to research grower licenses.

"<u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2022 Act is repealed on June 30,
2023.".

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
