**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4077**

1 On page 4 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 12, delete “21” and insert  
2 “22”.

3 In line 21, delete “21” and insert “22”.

4 In line 25, delete “21” and insert “22”.

5 On page 14, line 8, delete “21” and insert “22” and after line 10, insert:

7 **“FISCAL PROVISIONS**

9 **“SECTION 20. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other ap-**  
10 **propriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Environmental**  
11 **Quality, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the General**  
12 **Fund, the amount of \$324,520, for implementing section 12 of this 2022**  
13 **Act and to provide administrative support for the Environmental**  
14 **Justice Council.**

15 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund**  
16 **appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (1),**  
17 **chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023,**  
18 **for health systems, health policy and analytics, and public health, is**  
19 **increased by \$123,586 for implementing section 12 of this 2022 Act.**

20 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund**  
21 **appropriation made to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission**

1 by section 1 (8), chapter 660, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium end-  
2 ing June 30, 2023, for public university statewide programs, is in-  
3 creased by \$191,355 for the Institute for Natural Resources and the  
4 Portland State University Population Research Center, to carry out  
5 the provisions of section 12 of this 2022 Act.

6 “(4) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-  
7 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (3), chapter 425, Oregon  
8 Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the maximum  
9 limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,  
10 including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received from  
11 charges, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described  
12 in section 2, chapter 425, Oregon Laws 2021, collected or received by  
13 the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the office of  
14 Enterprise Information Services, is increased by \$129,937 to carry out  
15 the provisions of section 12 of this 2022 Act.”.
