RE: SB 1509


Chair Manning, Vice-Chair Thomsen, and members of the committee:

We have many friends, dating all the way back to our college days, whose families spent WWII in internment camps with all of the attendant shame and loss that went with that experience. Our friendships have led us to read and explore deeply the Japanese-American experience during the war, and we have visited the sites of a number of the camps in recent years.
