Please do not take away the right of the school boards, as voted by representatives of the community, to do what is necessary with regards to administration. The school board's main purpose is to hire a superintendent and then monitor, for the community, that said person is doing the job they have been hired to do-mainly following board approved policies. The board makes policies and needs them to be followed or what was the point of having a school board elected by the people?

Stop this bill. Continue to allow school boards to represent the community and do the job they were given to do. Our schools are not about protecting administrative staff but the children and those elected to represent them and their families.
