My Name is Lino I have worked for over 25 years as a farm worker. For example, as a tractor operator, picking tomatoes, lettuce, grape harvest, and the potato harvest and I currently am working at a dairy farm in Oregon and my job involves inseminating the cows for more than 12 years.

I support Overtime because primarily, farm work is very difficult. And if I could earn overtime pay, it would help me and my family economically.

My shift starts at 5am and I sometimes work over 60 hours in a week, depending on how much work there is to get done.

I support HB 4002 and ask for your support on this proposal to grant Overtime to Farm Workers in Oregon.
